# PRESENTING THE DOCTRINE IN INDIANA



She disperses her wisdom and insight. She teaches them through word and deed. I love watching the faces of my children and grandchildren when she interacts with them. Sometimes I sit on my bed at night and feel the goodness of it all. I realize I have a treasure so many others do not have. And I give praise to God for His favor towards me.
