Last Friday we returned from our Tennessee Campus Tour. During the four days of the tour – March 23rd to 26th – we put out over 20,000 pieces of literature to the university students, had countless conversations and debates, displayed the large photographs of the preborn developing in the womb and murdered by abortion, and preached God's Word and Gospel.

Please pray that many seeds were planted and many seeds watered regarding the Gospel.

Please pray also that those students who claim Christ and Christianity will desire to take action on behalf of their preborn neighbor in need and no longer pass by on the other side of the road like the priest and the Levite.

Starting on the back of this page is a summary about our efforts on this campus tour – with a brief report from each day. We ran into conflict with the authorities on the Tennessee campuses every day – yet were able to put out a massive amount of literature each day. The fourth day we decided to go to Western Kentucky University where you can minister unmolested by the authorities as they respect the First Amendment. It was an awesome day of ministry!

The two main pieces of literature we used for the tour we produced ourselves. One addresses chemical abortions (which make up *over 60%* of abortions now!). The other piece was our well-known Why We Show the Bloody Photographs which addresses surgical abortions. There are over 650 deathcamps in America.

We also supplied those who made up our team with dropcards which speak up for the preborn and point men to Christ so that wherever they were they could hand the to people or place them in strategic places. We had a core team of 35 people who traveled on this tour with others who joined in here and there.

Thank you for all your prayers and support! May the Lamb that was slain receive the reward of His suffering.

DAY ONE OF TENNESSEE CAMPUS TOUR

Monday, March 23rd

We gathered at the University of Tennessee in Chattanooga. Major trouble with the authorities. Police nearly arrested all of us. Our lawyers from Liberty Counsel are working on the matter. Nevertheless, we were still able to impact thousands of students with literature, photographs, and preaching. After the campus, we set up our display of the preborn, passed out tons of literature, and preached His Word at a busy intersection.



DAY TWO

Tuesday, March 24th

Middle Tennessee State in Murfreesboro. Sadly - again - trouble from the authorities.

Tennessee claims to prize freedom, but their policies at universities are unconstitutional and tyrannical. Once again after two hours we were forced off campus under threat of arrest. Even if you get a permit (which we are loathe to do because men fought, bled, and died for the freedoms we possess), they put you in a little spot you have to stay in where you do not reach the vast majority of students. They appear to want to make the entire campus a "safe place" for students. The people wanting free speech shut down seems to be the sodomites and Muslims along with their politically-correct friends. Nevertheless, our people put out tons of lit while a few of us parlayed with police. It seemed nearly every student had a piece of our literature before we were finally forced off campus. Afterwards we went and did an incredibly busy intersection in Smyrna where the lit went out well, the preaching of the Word and admonitions were declared - and there was no trouble from the authorities. DAY THREE

Wednesday, March 25th

We went to Tennessee State University in Nashville. Again trouble with the authorities. They claim we need permission to speak because of “safety.” History shows that “safety” has often been used to introduce a tyranny. We played cat and mouse with the police for nearly 3 hours before the last of us were removed from campus under threat of arrest. But, our literature was everywhere at that point and many good conversations were had. Some from our team - after being removed at TSU - went to nearby Vanderbilt University and put out much lit there to the students. Afterwards we went to the Capitol to speak to the magistrates (who sadly had just killed a bill of abolition of abortion two weeks earlier) and to passers-by. In God’s providence, about 30 or 40 legislators were standing outside for a photo-op. Our team was able to preach and hold them accountable while also displaying our large photographs of the murdered preborn to them. Please pray for the students and legislators.

Thursday, March 26th

We went to Western Kentucky University in Bowling Green. A massive amount of literature went out as we were able to minister unmolested by the authorities. Everyone had to keep going back to the van to get more lit! Many great conversations also - but one woman with our group was assaulted and another had a drink dumped on her. Please pray the literature gets passed to many more hands besides those who took it, and that the Lord would work mightily in the hearts and minds of the students. May Christ be praised!
