Dear Friends of the Preborn,

Enclosed is a short report about our latest Campus Tour ministry. We have been going to universities for 27 years now. The Lord put our hand to that plow. The young people who attend there will be leaders in business and government and academia in the decades to come. They need to hear the truth of God's law, Word, and Gospel.

I remember one of the motivating reasons that pushed us to the universities and high schools was that those of us who were missionaries at Missionaries to the Preborn back in 1996 were being hammered with long jail sentences for simply ministering outside the deathcamps in Milwaukee. The courts had ordered us to stay away from the deathcamps (and many of us had done months in jail for not obeying).

But what they meant for evil – the Lord used for good.

We decided since the government wants to keep us away from the deathcamps - *we would take what is happening at the deathcamps out to the nation.* With the photographs and literature. Revealing the horror of abortion. And calling men to repentance and pointing them to Christ.

So we headed to America's busy traffic intersections out on the streets; we headed to the high schools – and we headed to the universities.

Doing so was a goodness. The photographs are an indictment on our nation. Children have been spared a brutal murder by moms seeing the signs. Sometimes the Lord uses the tyrants themselves to guide us in what we should do.

Thank you for all you do in supporting our efforts in prayer and financially – as this enables us to continue on with what the Lord has given us to do.

May the Lamb that was slain receive the reward of His suffering!

First abolition conference held in Canada!

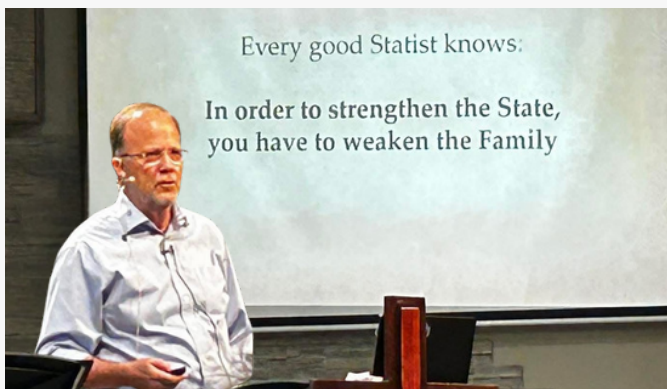
Pastor Matt was blessed and honored to participate in and speak at the first abolitionist conference in Canada - held in Toronto September 18-20th.

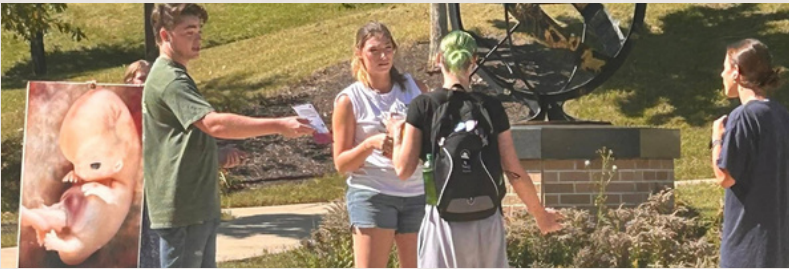


CAMPUS TOUR FOR THE PREBORN

SEPTEMBER 15TH – 18TH 2025

Just five days after the shooting at the university in Utah – Missionaries to the Preborn went out to three universities in Wisconsin and one in Illinois on a Campus Tour which had been planned for months.

We had a core group of about 20 people and had about 30-35 people participating each day. We saw the Lord working in the hearts of the students!



Day One:

University of Wisconsin-Whitewater. Nearly 30 people came out to the campus to minister. Boatloads of literature went out - and lots of one on one and small group conversations took place. Pray the Lord works mightily in the hearts and minds of the students.



Day Two:

University of Wisconsin-Madison (known as 'the Berkeley of the Midwest'). No small stir!

Lots of conversations and interactions.

Crowds of people gathered – hundreds!

Much literature poured into the campus. Preaching all day - including times of Q&A with the students.





Day Three:

Northwestern University in Illinois. No small stir! The entire student body was talking about abortion and discussing Christianity.

Much literature went out; signs were attacked; countless conversations took place.



Day Four:

University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. There were a ton of good one-on-one and small group conversations the whole day. Open air preaching to various crowds including again - a time of Q&A with the students.

Finally – at every university – each day of the Tour – we had students try to steal or destroy our signs. Fortunately, we were able to retrieve any grabbed and taken and keep any from being destroyed. (We are not pacifists.)
